

## C. W. Mount Community Center and Banquet Facility

### Rules and Regulations for the Service and Consumption of Alcohol

For ALL events with Beer, Wine, or Liquor available for complimentary or cash bar consumption:

A Lessee that desires alcoholic beverages at their event must hire our in-house beverage partner, Indy's Best Bar Service. Indy's Best Bar Service provides fully-licensed and insured bartending services and has the desire to consult with you personally to find a bar package that best-fits your service and budgetary needs.

- A. Alcohol will be served or distributed only by employees of Indy's Best Bar Service.
- B. Open drinks must be consumed inside of the Banquet Hall.
  - a. No open beverages may be carried into the hallway, outdoors, or in other areas of the building.
- C. Alcoholic bottles (wine, beer, etc.) purchased as a whole, must remain unopened until buyer is off of the premises of the Mount Center.

Hosts and guests at an event must comply with the following:

- a.) Provide acceptable identification: valid driver's license with a photograph.
- b.) In the absence of authentic identification, or in case of doubt, the Bartender will refuse service of alcoholic beverages to the host/ guest.
- c.) Hosts/Guests are NOT allowed to bring in their own alcohol.
- d.) Hosts/Guests are NOT allowed to "pour" any drinks.
- e.) The service of alcoholic beverages shall not begin prior to 6pm weekdays or Noon on weekends.

The C.W. Mount Community Center and/or Indy's Best Bar reserves the right to refuse authorization to serve alcoholic beverages to any individual or group. No alcoholic beverages will be allowed outside the designated event area. Rental policy requires that alcoholic beverages be served and consumed only in the space rented for the occasion. Extra security may be required by the C.W. Mount Community Center at a cost to the renter based on the nature of the event or the size of the group.

The C.W. Mount Community Center and Indy's Best Bar Service has the authority to suspend the serving of alcoholic beverages or terminate the rental function due to the abuse of the facility, staff, or failure of rental guests to follow C.W. Mount Community Center policies with no recourse or refund of any rental, or service fees whatsoever.

Violation of these provisions, or suspension of the event due to violations shall result in a forfeited deposit, and the inability to rent C.W. Mount Community Center facility in the future.
